"PRAYER IS MISSIONAL"

WHERE PRAYER LEADS US

13 1 Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul. 2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." 3 So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. (Acts 13:1-3 NIV)

A PRAYING CHURCH IS A LISTENING CHURCH

While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting...
(Acts 13:2a NIV)

THE SPIRIT INITIATES THE MISSION

The Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.'
(Acts 13:2b NIV)

PRAYER PRECEDES SENDING

So after they had fasted and prayed...
(Acts 13:3a NIV)

PRAYER MOVES US FROM COMFORT TO CALLING

...they placed their hands on them and sent them off.
(Acts 13:3b NIV)

Talking Points

START THINKING: We often treat prayer like a waiting room instead of a runway. Why is it easier to pray for comfort than to pray for direction? In Acts 13, the church prays before making plans. How does that challenge the way we usually make decisions? The Holy Spirit initiates the mission, not the leaders. What happens when churches move out of urgency or fear instead of listening? Prayer doesn't just change circumstances — it repositions people. Where might God be repositioning you right now?

START SHARING: Share a time when prayer led you to take action, not just feel peace. What happened when you obeyed? Is there a place in your life where you've been praying —but avoiding the next step God may be asking you to take? The church at Antioch released trusted leaders for mission. What is hardest for you to release when God calls you forward? When you think about our church, who or where do you sense God might be sending you?

START DOING: This week, pray one simple prayer each day: "Holy Spirit, where are You sending me today?" Take one intentional step: Start a conversation Offer help. Extend an invitation. Show compassion without being asked. Identify one place where you can pray forward: Your neighborhood, Your workplace, Your school, A relationship that needs healing. As a group, commit to pray first before planning this week.
