Come for the game, stay for the fun!



"GOD HEARS THE CRY"

WHEN LIFE FEELS HEAVY, NOT DRAMATIC

24 Then Joseph said to his brothers, "I am about to die. But God will surely come to your aid and take you up out of this land to the land he promised on oath to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." 25 And Joseph made the Israelites swear an oath and said, "God will surely come to your aid, and then you must carry my bones up from this place."
(Genesis 50:24-25 NIV)

23 During that long period, the king of Egypt died. The Israelites groaned in their slavery and cried out, and their cry for help because of their slavery went up to God. (Exodus 2:23 NIV)

WHEN FEAR RULES, OPPRESSION GROWS

8 Then a new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing, came to power in Egypt. 9 "Look," he said to his people, "the Israelites have become far too numerous for us. 10 Come, we must deal shrewdly with them or they will become even more numerous and, if war breaks out, will join our enemies, fight against us and leave the country." 11 So they put slave masters over them to oppress them with forced labor, and they built Pithom and Rameses as store cities for Pharaoh. 12 But the more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied and spread; so the Egyptians came to dread the Israelites 13 and worked them ruthlessly. 14 They made their lives bitter with harsh labor in brick and mortar and with all kinds of work in the fields; in all their harsh labor the Egyptians worked them ruthlessly.
(Exodus 1:8-14 NIV)

GOD'S SILENCE IS NOT GOD'S ABSENCE

1 How long, Lord? Will you forget me forever? How long will you hide your face from me? 2 How long must I wrestle with my thoughts and day after day have sorrow in my heart? How long will my enemy triumph over me?
(Psalm 13: 1-2)

GOD MOVES BEFORE WE SEE RESULTS

24 God heard their groaning and he remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob. 25 So God looked on the Israelites and was concerned about them.
(Exodus 2:24-25 NIV)

Talking Points

Start Thinking: Where does life feel heavy or unending right now? Do I believe God hears honest cries, not just perfect prayers?

Start Sharing: Share a season when waiting tested your faith. Where have you struggled to see God at work?

Start Doing: Bring one honest concern to God this week. Trust that God is already at work, even if nothing looks different yet.
