PASSED OVER WEEK 6: "THE WAY THROUGH THE WATERS"

THE LORD SOMETIMES LEADS US INTO IMPOSSIBLE PLACES

1 Then the Lord said to Moses, 2 “Tell the Israelites to turn back and encamp near Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea. They are to encamp by the sea, directly opposite Baal Zephon. 3 Pharaoh will think, ‘The Israelites are wandering around the land in confusion, hemmed in by the desert.’ 4 And I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, and he will pursue them. But I will gain glory for myself through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the Lord.” So the Israelites did this. (Exodus 14:1-4 NIV)

FEAR REVEALS WHAT WE STILL TRUST

10 As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up, and there were the Egyptians, marching after them. They were terrified and cried out to the Lord. 11 They said to Moses, “Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt? 12 Didn’t we say to you in Egypt, ‘Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians’? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!” (Exodus 14:10–12 NIV)

THE LORD FIGHTS FOR HIS PEOPLE

13 Moses answered the people, “Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. 14 The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still.” (Exodus 14:13–14 NIV)

THE WAY FORWARD IS THROUGH....

21 Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and all that night the Lord drove the sea back with a strong east wind and turned it into dry land. The waters were divided, 22 and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left. (Exodus 14:21–22 NIV)

WHAT ONCE THREATENED YOU BECOMES A TESTIMONY

26 Then the Lord said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand over the sea so that the waters may flow back over the Egyptians and their chariots and horsemen.” 27 Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and at daybreak the sea went back to its place. The Egyptians were fleeing toward[c] it, and the Lord swept them into the sea. 28 The water flowed back and covered the chariots and horsemen—the entire army of Pharaoh that had followed the Israelites into the sea. Not one of them survived. 29 But the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left. 30 That day the Lord saved Israel from the hands of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying dead on the shore. 31 And when the Israelites saw the mighty hand of the Lord displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the Lord and put their trust in him and in Moses his servant. (Exodus 14: 26-31 NIV)

WHERE IS YOUR SEA?

1 For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. 2. They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. (1 Corinthians 10:1-2 NIV)

Talking Points

Start Thinking: Where do I feel trapped right now? Is fear shaping my response more than faith? What “sea” feels impossible in front of me?

Start Sharing: Share a time when God made a way unexpectedly. Where are you tempted to go back to what once enslaved you? What fear do you need prayer for this week?

Start Doing: Stand firm instead of reacting in fear. Take one step of obedience toward the “sea.”

Pray: “Lord, fight for me where I cannot.” Choose trust over retreat this week.
