"WEEK 1: FOLLOW ME"

FOLLOW ME

18 As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. **19** “Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” **20** At once they left their nets and followed him. **21** Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. Jesus called them, **22** and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him. (Matthew 4:18-22 NIV)

FOLLOWING CHANGES YOU

Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” (Matthew 4:19b NIV)

Talking Points

Start Thinking: Do I simply believe in Jesus, or am I actually following Him? What am I holding onto that is keeping me from fully following Jesus? Where in my life is Jesus saying, “Come, follow me”?

Start Sharing: When did following Jesus become real for you—not just belief? What has been hardest for you to “leave behind” in your faith journey? Where have you seen God change you as you’ve followed Him?

Start Doing: Take one step this week to follow Jesus more intentionally. Identify one thing you need to leave behind—and surrender it to God. Spend time daily asking: “Jesus, where are you leading me today?” Choose obedience in one area you’ve been delaying.

Prayer:

“Lord Jesus, thank you for calling us to follow you. Give us the courage to leave behind what holds us back and the faith to take the next step. Shape our lives as we walk with you. Amen.”

NOTES:
