God Reminds Them of Grace First

3 Then Moses went up to God, and the Lord called to him from the mountain and said, "This is what you are to say to the descendants of Jacob and what you are to tell the people of Israel: 4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. (Exodus 19:3–4 NIV)

God Forms a Covenant People

5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites." (Exodus 19:5–6 NIV)

God Reveals His Character

1 And God spoke all these words: 2 "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. 3 "You shall have no other gods before me. (Exodus 20:1–3 NIV)

Freedom Has a Shape

8 "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns. 11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy. (Exodus 20:8–11 NIV)

Formed on the Mountains...

1 Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, 2 and he began to teach them. (Matthew 5:1–2 NIV)

17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. (Matthew 5:17 NIV)

33 I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. (Jeremiah 31:33 NIV)

The Greater Covenant Formed and Fulfilled

20 This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. (Luke 22:20 NIV)

Talking Points

Start Thinking: God rescued Israel before giving them His commandments. Grace always comes before formation. God doesn't just free His people—He forms them. How does this truth resonate in your heart?

Start Sharing: Where have you experienced God's grace before you understood His direction? How has God been shaping your life since coming to faith? What does it mean to live as God's "treasured possession" today?

Start Doing: Ask God this week: "What are you forming in me?" Choose one area of life where you want to better reflect God's character. Thank God daily for His grace that comes before our obedience. Prayer: "Lord, thank you for rescuing us by grace. Continue to shape our hearts and lives so that we reflect your love and holiness in the world. Amen."
